FACE: Paper plate / Card-Stock / Paper (Can Pre-cut in Circle Shape)


MANE: Construction paper/Tissue paper


Or Recycled Materials (Newspaper, Magazines, Leaves)

Can be any shape, even square or rectangle.




Tear MANE strips\*



Glue strips around FACE, keeping center space clear.

Be generous with glue, and let dry completely before next step.






1. Cut out eyes, "D" shapes for ears, triangle shape for nose


2. Or draw free-hand (See step #5)

3. Or glue/attach googly eyes











### Easy Cake Mix Cookies

#### Ingredients

- 1 (15.25 ounce) package of white cake mix
- ½ cup vegetable oil
- 2 large eggs



#### Steps



- 2. Combine cake mix, oil, and eggs in a large bowl, stirring until a dough forms.
- 3. Shape the dough into 1-inch balls and arrange them 2 inches apart on ungreased baking sheets.
- 4. Bake in the preheated oven for approximately 6 to 10 minutes, adjusting based on your desired level of softness.
- 5. Allow the cookies to cool on the baking sheet for 5 minutes before transferring them to a wire rack to cool completely.
- 6. Indulge and enjoy!


